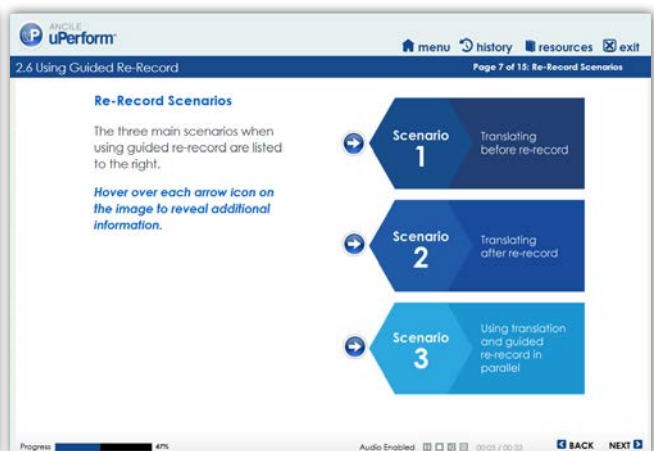
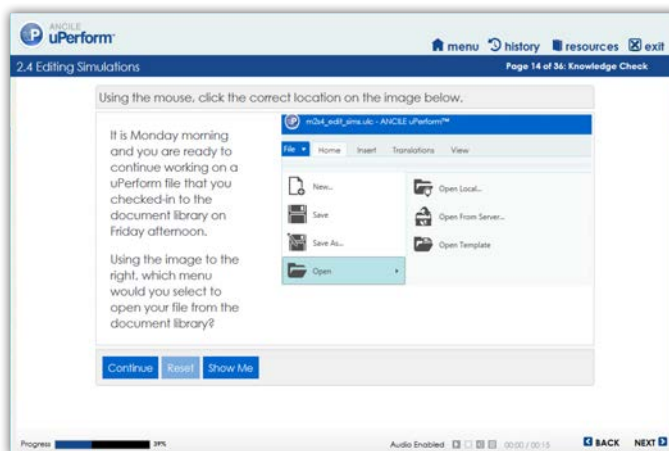

- Learn how to publish your content for review.

Module 3: Working with eLearning Courses

- Create and edit lessons and content pages.
- Master the steps to import graphics, video, and PowerPoint content.
- Develop multiple types of knowledge checks and assessments.

Module 4: Working with the ANCILE uPerform Server

- Check your content into the uPerform server for workflow and collaboration, and add existing non-uPerform content to the server.
